Page 51, after line 14, add the following:

1 **SEC. _____. INCREASING EDUCATION AMONG FRONTLINE**
2 **HEALTH CARE WORKERS AND LAW ENFORCE-**
3 **MENT OF INCREASED RISK POSED BY**
4 **EMERGING SYNTHETIC OPIOIDS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
6 Human Services (in this section referred to as the “Sec-
7 retary”) shall develop, and disseminate to qualified front-
8 line workers, educational materials on emerging synthetic
9 opioids, such as nitazines, which address—

10 (1) the prevalence of emerging synthetic
11 opioids;

12 (2) the potency of such synthetic opioids in re-
13 lation to fentanyl and heroin;

14 (3) dosage information for reversing an over-
15 dose of such synthetic opioids with naloxone; and

16 (4) such additional information, as determined
17 to be appropriate by the Secretary.

1 (b) QUALIFIED FRONTLINE WORKER DEFINED.—In
2 this section, the term “qualified frontline worker”
3 means—

4 (1) a member of law enforcement (as defined in
5 section 40002 of the Violence Against Women Act of
6 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12291)); and

7 (2) an individual who provides health care serv-
8 ices in—

9 (A) a local emergency medical services sys-
10 tem;

11 (B) a hospital;

12 (C) a Federally qualified health care center
13 (as defined in section 1861(aa) of the Social
14 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(aa)));

15 (D) a homeless service provider (as defined
16 in section 41403 of the Violence Against
17 Women Act of 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12473)); and

18 (E) another health care setting that re-
19 ceives Federal funds.
