Amendment to H.R. 2670 Offered by Mr. Waltz of Florida

Add at the end of subtitle E of title VIII the following new section:

1	SEC. 8 DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE GOALS FOR PAR-
2	TICIPATION BY CERTAIN VETERAN-OWNED
3	SMALL BUSINESSES IN PROCUREMENT CON-
4	TRACTS.

5 Chapter 287 of part V of title 10, United States
6 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
7 section:

8 "§ 3906. Small business concerns owned and con9 trolled by veterans: contracting goals and
10 preferences

"(a) CONTRACTING GOALS.—In order to increase
contracting opportunities for small business concerns
owned and controlled by veterans and small business concerns owned and controlled by service-disabled veterans,
the Secretary shall—

"(1) establish a goal for each fiscal year for
participation in Department contracts (including
subcontracts) by small business concerns owned and
controlled by veterans who are not service-disabled

veterans that is not less than the Governmentwide
 goal for that fiscal year for participation by small
 business concerns owned and controlled by service disabled veterans under section 15(g)(1) of the
 Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 644(g)(1)); and

6 "(2) establish a goal for each fiscal year for 7 participation in Department contracts (including 8 subcontracts) by small business concerns owned and 9 controlled by veterans with service-connected disabil-10 ities that is not less than the Governmentwide goal 11 for that fiscal year for participation by small busi-12 ness concerns owned and controlled by service-dis-13 abled veterans under section 15(g)(1) of the Small 14 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 644(g)(1)).

15 "(b) Sole Source Contracts for Contracts Above Simplified Acquisition Threshold.—For pur-16 poses of meeting the goals under subsection (a) and in 17 18 accordance with this section, a contracting officer may 19 award a contract to a small business concern owned and 20 controlled by veterans or small business concerns owned 21 and controlled by service-disabled veterans using proce-22 dures other than competitive procedures if—

23 "(1) such concern is determined to be a respon24 sible source with respect to performance of such con25 tract opportunity;

"(2) the anticipated award price of the contract
 (including options) will not exceed the amounts es tablished in section 36(c)(2) of the Small Business
 Act (15 U.S.C. 657f(c)(2)); and

5 "(3) in the estimation of the contracting officer,
6 the contract award can be made at a fair and rea7 sonable price that offers best value to the United
8 States.

9 "(c) Use of Restricted Competition.—Except as 10 provided in subsections (b) and (c), for purposes of meeting the goals under subsection (a) and in accordance with 11 this section, a contracting officer shall award contracts on 12 the basis of competition restricted to small business con-13 14 cerns owned and controlled by veterans or small business 15 concerns owned and controlled by service-disabled veterans if the contracting officer has a reasonable expectation that 16 two or more small business concerns owned and controlled 17 by veterans or small business concerns owned and con-18 19 trolled by service-disabled veterans (as applicable) will 20submit offers and that the award can be made at a fair 21 and reasonable price that offers best value to the United 22 States.

23 "(d) ELIGIBILITY OF SMALL BUSINESS CON24 CERNS.—A small business concern may be awarded a con25 tract under this section only if the small business concern

4	"(e) Priority for Contracting Preferences.—
5	Preferences for awarding contracts to small business con-
6	cerns shall be applied in the following order of priority:
7	"(1) Contracts awarded pursuant to subsection
8	(b) or (c) to small business concerns owned and con-
9	trolled by service-disabled veterans.
10	"(2) Contracts awarded pursuant to subsection
11	(b) or (c) to small business concerns owned and con-
12	trolled by veterans that are not covered by para-
13	graph (1).
14	"(3) Contracts awarded pursuant to—
15	"(A) section 8(a) of the Small Business
16	Act (15 U.S.C. 637(a)); or
17	"(B) section 31 of such Act (15 U.S.C.
18	657a).
19	"(4) Contracts awarded pursuant to any other
20	contracting preference for small business concerns.
21	"(f) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
22	"(1) The term 'small business concern' has the
23	meaning given under section 3 of the Small Business
24	Act (15 U.S.C. 632).

"(2) The terms 'service-disabled veteran', 'small
 business concern owned and controlled by veterans',
 and 'small business concern owned and controlled by
 service-disabled veterans' have the meanings given,
 respectively, under section 3(q) of the Small Busi ness Act (15 U.S.C. 632(q)).".
