

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-10**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. WAGNER OF MISSOURI**

At the end of subtitle A of title XIII, add the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . PERIODIC REVIEWS AND UPDATED REPORTS OF**  
2 **THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE'S TAIWAN**  
3 **GUIDELINES UNDER THE TAIWAN ASSUR-**  
4 **ANCE ACT OF 2020.**

5 Section 315 of the Taiwan Assurance Act of 2020  
6 (Public Law 116-260; 134 Stat. 3100) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (c)(1), by adding at the end  
8 before “; and” the following: “and any successor  
9 document or related document disseminating such  
10 guidance”; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(d) PERIODIC REVIEWS AND UPDATED REPORTS.—

13 “(1) IN GENERAL.—For as long as the Depart-  
14 ment of State’s guidance that governs relations with  
15 Taiwan described in subsection (a) remains in effect,  
16 the Secretary of State shall conduct periodic reviews  
17 as described in subsection (a) and submit updated  
18 reports as described in subsection (c) not less fre-

1           quently than every two years following the submis-  
2           sion of the initial report described in subsection (c).

3           “(2) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—Such up-  
4           dated reports shall include—

5                   “(A) a description of how the guidance  
6                   meets the goals and objectives described in  
7                   paragraphs (1), (2), and (3) of subsection (b);  
8                   and

9                   “(B) an identification of opportunities and  
10                  plans to lift self-imposed restrictions on rela-  
11                  tions with Taiwan.

12                  “(C) an explanation of how the guidance  
13                  fulfills the policies set forth in the Taiwan Rela-  
14                  tions Act, including how it supports the United  
15                  States capacity to resist any resort to force or  
16                  other forms of coercion that would jeopardize  
17                  the security, or the social or economic system of  
18                  the people on Taiwan.”.
