

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-54
OFFERED BY MR. WALBERG OF MICHIGAN

At the end of subtitle B of title XII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 12__ . ADDITIONAL REPORTING OF REFUSED ASSIST-**
2 **ANCE TO THE SPECIAL INSPECTOR GENERAL**
3 **FOR AFGHANISTAN RECONSTRUCTION BY**
4 **SECRETARY OF STATE, SECRETARY OF DE-**
5 **FENSE, OR ADMINISTRATOR FOR UNITED**
6 **STATES AGENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL DE-**
7 **VELOPMENT.**

8 Section 1229(h)(5) of the National Defense Author-
9 ization Act for Fiscal Year 2008 (Public Law 110-181;
10 5 U.S.C. App. 8G note) is amended by adding at the end
11 following:

12 “(C) ADDITIONAL REPORTING OF RE-
13 FUSED ASSISTANCE BY SECRETARY OF STATE,
14 SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, OR ADMINISTRATOR
15 FOR UNITED STATES AGENCY FOR INTER-
16 NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT.—

17 “(i) IN GENERAL.—Whenever infor-
18 mation or assistance requested by the In-
19 spector General is, in the judgment of the

1 Inspector General, unreasonably refused or
2 not provided by the Secretary of State, the
3 Secretary of Defense, or the Administrator
4 for United States Agency for International
5 Development, such Secretary or Adminis-
6 trator shall, not later than 30 days after
7 Inspector General determines such infor-
8 mation or assistance has been unreason-
9 ably refused or not provided, submit to the
10 appropriate congressional committees a re-
11 port on why the Secretary or Adminis-
12 trator is refusing to provide the requested
13 information or assistance.

14 “(ii) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL
15 COMMITTEES DEFINED.—In this subpara-
16 graph, the term ‘appropriate congressional
17 committees’ means—

18 “(I) the Committee on Armed
19 Services, the Committee on Oversight
20 and Reform, the Committee on For-
21 eign Affairs, and the Committee on
22 Appropriations of the House of Rep-
23 resentatives; and

24 “(II) the Committee on Armed
25 Services, the Committee on Foreign

1 Relations, and the Committee on Ap-
2 propriations of the Senate.”.
