

**AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116–19
OFFERED BY MR. WALDEN OF OREGON**

At the end of subtitle B of title V, add the following:

1 **SEC. 520. TEMPORARY AUTHORITY TO USE AIR FORCE RE-**
2 **SERVE COMPONENT PERSONNEL TO PRO-**
3 **VIDE TRAINING AND INSTRUCTION REGARD-**
4 **ING PILOT TRAINING.**

5 (a) **AUTHORITY.**—

6 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—During fiscal year 2020, the
7 Secretary of the Air Force may authorize personnel
8 described in paragraph (2) to provide training and
9 instruction regarding pilot training to the following:

10 (A) Members of the Armed Forces on ac-
11 tive duty.

12 (B) Members of foreign military forces who
13 are in the United States.

14 (2) **PERSONNEL.**—The personnel described in
15 this paragraph are the following:

16 (A) Members of the reserve components of
17 the Air Force on active Guard and Reserve
18 duty (as that term is defined in section 101(d)
19 of title 10, United States Code) who are not

1 otherwise authorized to conduct the training de-
2 scribed in paragraph (1) due to the limitations
3 in section 12310 of title 10, United States
4 Code.

5 (B) Members of the Air Force who are
6 military technicians (dual status) who are not
7 otherwise authorized to conduct the training de-
8 scribed in paragraph (1) due to the limitations
9 in section 10216 of title 10, United States
10 Code, and section 709(a) of title 32, United
11 States Code.

12 (3) LIMITATION.—Not more than 50 members
13 described in paragraph (2) may provide training and
14 instruction under the authority in paragraph (1) at
15 any one time.

16 (4) FEDERAL TORT CLAIMS ACT.—Members of
17 the uniformed services described in paragraph (2)
18 who provide training and instruction pursuant to the
19 authority in paragraph (1) shall be covered by the
20 Federal Tort Claims Act for purposes of any claim
21 arising from the employment of such individuals
22 under that authority.

23 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
24 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Air
25 Force shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services

1 of the Senate and the House of Representatives a report
2 setting forth a plan to eliminate shortages in the number
3 of pilot instructors within the Air Force using authorities
4 available to the Secretary under current law.
