

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8595, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. WALKINSHAW OF VIRGINIA**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), add the following:

1 TITLE IX—REPORT

2 SEC. __. (a) Not later than 180 days after the date
3 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State shall
4 submit to the appropriate congressional committees a re-
5 port on the use of unapproved artificial intelligence models
6 or artificial intelligence-powered applications, also known
7 as “shadow AI”, within information technology networks
8 of the Department of State, and any cybersecurity risks
9 and data exposure vulnerabilities introduced by such use.

10 (b) The report required by subsection (a) shall in-
11 clude the following:

12 (1) The steps the Secretary is taking to monitor
13 and identify shadow AI in such technology infra-
14 structure.

15 (2) The steps the Secretary is taking to miti-
16 gate cybersecurity and data security risks of shadow
17 AI.

18 (3) A detailed assessment of any known or sus-
19 pected data leakage resulting from shadow AI.

1 (4) The steps taken to develop plans to either
2 transition unapproved AI systems into sanctioned IT
3 environments, decommission unapproved systems al-
4 together, or implement security controls and reme-
5 diate shadow AI once discovered.

6 (c) The report required by subsection (a) shall be
7 submitted in unclassified form, and shall include an un-
8 classified executive summary.

9 (d) The unclassified executive summary of the report
10 required by subsection (a) shall be published on a publicly
11 accessible website of the Department of State

12 (e) Not later than 30 days after the submission of
13 the report required by subsection (a), the Secretary shall
14 provide to the appropriate congressional committees a
15 briefing on the findings, conclusions, and recommenda-
16 tions contained in such report.

17 (f) In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
18 sional committees” means—

19 (1) the Committee on Appropriations of the
20 House of Representatives; and

21 (2) the Committee on Appropriations of the
22 Senate.
