Page 1024, after line 6, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 1706. REPORT ON AGILE PROGRAM AND PROJECT**
2 **MANAGEMENT.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of
5 the United States shall submit to the Committee on
6 Armed Services of the Senate and the Committee on
7 Armed Services of the House of Representatives a publicly
8 available report on agile program and project management
9 within the Department of Defense. The report shall in-
10 clude the following:

11 (1) A review of all statutory provisions enabling
12 the use of agile program and project management
13 within the Department of Defense.

14 (2) An evaluation of the implementation of stat-
15 utory provisions enabling the use of agile program
16 and project management within the Department of
17 Defense and Armed Forces.

1 (3) An evaluation of the agile program and
2 project methodologies used within the Department of
3 Defense and Armed Forces.

4 (4) An evaluation of the how agile program and
5 project methodologies have enabled efforts to pre-
6 pare the Department of Defense and Armed Forces
7 for the future of work.

8 (5) An evaluation of the enterprise scalability of
9 the agile program and project methodologies used
10 within the Department of Defense and Armed
11 Forces, including how well agile methods are inte-
12 grated into the enterprise when used at scale.

13 (6) An analysis of the impediments to the fur-
14 ther adoption and enterprise scalability of agile pro-
15 gram and project management including statutory
16 impediments, as well as existing policy, guidance,
17 and instruction of the Department of Defense and
18 Armed Forces.

19 (7) An analysis of the impact of further adop-
20 tion and enterprise scalability of agile program and
21 project management on the future of work within
22 the Department of Defense and Armed Forces.

23 (8) Such other information as the Comptroller
24 General determines appropriate.

1 (b) INTERIM BRIEFING.—Not later than March 1,
2 2021, the Comptroller General shall provide to the Com-
3 mittee on Armed Services of the Senate and the Com-
4 mittee on Armed Services of the House of Representatives
5 a briefing on the topics to be covered by the report under
6 subsection (a), including and preliminary data and any
7 issues or concerns of the Comptroller General relating to
8 the report.

9 (c) ACCESS TO RELEVANT DATA.—For purposes of
10 this section, the Secretary of Defense shall ensure that
11 the Comptroller General has access to all relevant data.
