Page 1334, after line 17, insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . UNITED STATES POLICY ON BURMA AT THE**
2 **INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—It is the policy of the United
4 States that it will not recognize or deal with the State
5 Administration Council, or any successor entity controlled
6 by the military, as the government of Burma for the pur-
7 pose of the provision of assistance from the international
8 financial institutions.

9 (b) **INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTION DE-**
10 **FINED.**—In subsection (a), the term “international finan-
11 cial institution” means the International Monetary Fund,
12 the International Bank for Reconstruction and Develop-
13 ment, the International Development Association, the
14 International Finance Corporation, the Multilateral In-
15 vestment Guarantee Agency, and the Asian Development
16 Bank.

17 (c) **POSITION OF THE UNITED STATES.**—Title XVI
18 of the International Financial Institutions Act (22 U.S.C.

1 262p-262p-13) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **“SEC. 1630. UNITED STATES POLICY ON BURMA AT THE**
4 **INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS.**

5 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Treasury shall
6 instruct the United States Executive Director at each
7 international financial institution to notify the respective
8 institution that the provision of any assistance to Burma
9 through the State Administration Council or any successor
10 entity controlled by the military, would be cause for a seri-
11 ous review of future United States participation in the in-
12 stitution.

13 “(b) INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTION DE-
14 FINED.—In subsection (a), the term ‘international finan-
15 cial institution’ means the International Monetary Fund,
16 the International Bank for Reconstruction and Develop-
17 ment, the International Development Association, the
18 International Finance Corporation, the Multilateral In-
19 vestment Guarantee Agency, and the Asian Development
20 Bank.”.
