At the end of title VIII, insert the following new section:

1SEC. 843. PREFERENCE FOR POTENTIAL DEFENSE CON-2TRACTORS THAT CARRY OUT CERTAIN STEM-3RELATED ACTIVITIES.

4 (a) PREFERENCE.—In evaluating offers submitted in
5 response to a solicitation for contracts, the Secretary of
6 Defense shall provide a preference to any offeror that—

7 (1) establishes or enhances undergraduate,
8 graduate, and doctoral programs in science, tech9 nology, engineering, and math (in this section re10 ferred to as "STEM" disciplines);

(2) makes investments, such as programming
and curriculum development, in STEM programs
within elementary and secondary schools;

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1	(4) makes personnel available to advise and as-
