AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4 OFFERED BY MS. MAXINE WATERS OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle D of title I, add the following:

1	SEC. 163. REGULATIONS TO REDUCE AIRPORT NOISE POL-
2	LUTION IN THE VICINITY OF HAWTHORNE
3	MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.
4	(a) REGULATIONS REQUIRED.—Not later than 1 year
5	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Adminis-
6	trator of the Federal Aviation Administration shall issue
7	regulations for aircraft operations at Hawthorne Munic-
8	ipal Airport, also known as Jack Northrop Field, in the
9	City of Hawthorne, California. These regulations shall in-
10	clude requirements relating to the flight paths, altitudes,
11	hours of operation, and quantities of flights per day asso-
12	ciated with such operations in order to increase safety and
13	reduce airport noise pollution in the surrounding commu-
14	nity.
15	(b) Exemptions.—In issuing the regulations under
16	subsection (a), the Administrator shall exempt aircraft op-
17	erations related to emergency, law enforcement, or mili-
18	tary activities from the requirements described in that
19	subsection.

- 1 (c) Consultations.—Before issuing regulations
- 2 under subsection (a), the Administrator shall make rea-
- 3 sonable efforts to consult with the local community and
- 4 local aircraft operators in order to develop regulations that
- 5 meet the needs of the local community, aircraft operators,
- 6 and the Federal Aviation Administration.
