

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 115-
76
OFFERED BY MS. MAXINE WATERS OF
CALIFORNIA**

Add at the end of title III the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____ . REQUIRING A SURVEY OF SUBSTANCE USE DIS-**
2 **ORDER TREATMENT PROVIDERS RECEIVING**
3 **FEDERAL FUNDING.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
5 Human Services (in this section referred to as the “Sec-
6 retary”) shall conduct a survey of all entities that receive
7 Federal funding for the purpose of providing substance
8 use disorder treatment services. The survey shall direct
9 such entities to provide the following information:

10 (1) The length of time the entity has provided
11 substance use disorder treatment services.

12 (2) A detailed description of the patient popu-
13 lation served by the entity, including but not limited
14 to the number of patients, type of addictions, geo-
15 graphic area served, as well as gender, racial, ethnic
16 and socioeconomic demographics of such patients.

1 (3) A detailed description of the types of addic-
2 tion for which the entity has the experience, capa-
3 bility, and capacity to provide such services.

4 (4) An explanation of how the entity handles
5 patients requiring treatment for a substance use dis-
6 order that the organization is not able to treat.

7 (5) A description of what is needed, in the opin-
8 ion of the entity, in order to improve the entity's
9 ability to meet the addiction treatment needs of the
10 communities served by that entity.

11 (6) Based on the identified needs of the com-
12 munities served, a description of unmet needs and
13 inadequate services and how such needs and services
14 could be better addressed through additional Fed-
15 eral, State, or local government resources or funding
16 to treat addiction to methamphetamine, crack co-
17 caine, other types of cocaine, heroin, opioids, and
18 other commonly abused drugs.

19 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
20 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall develop
21 and submit to Congress a plan to direct appropriate re-
22 sources to entities that provide substance use disorder
23 treatment services in order to address inadequacies in

- 1 services or funding identified through the survey described
- 2 in subsection (a).
