Page 208, line 11, strike “fiscal years 2019” and insert “fiscal years 2018”.

At the end of subtitle D of title I of division A, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . ADJUSTMENTS TO FUNDING LEVELS.**

2 (a) HIGHWAY ACCOUNT.—

3 (1) CUMULATIVE AUTHORIZATION.—Notwith-
4 standing any other provision of this Act, the cumu-
5 lative amount authorized for appropriation from the
6 Highway Trust Fund (other than the Mass Transit
7 Account)—

8 (A) under titles I, II, and VI of this Act—

9 (i) for fiscal year 2016 shall be
10 \$49,159,225,808;

11 (ii) for fiscal year 2017 shall be
12 \$50,024,114,365;

13 (iii) for fiscal year 2018 shall be
14 \$50,974,572,538;

1 (iv) for fiscal year 2019 shall be
2 \$51,994,063,989;

3 (v) for fiscal year 2020 shall be
4 \$53,033,945,268; and

5 (vi) for fiscal year 2021 shall be
6 \$54,094,624,174;

7 (B) under title IV of this Act—

8 (i) for fiscal year 2016 shall be
9 \$835,350,013;

10 (ii) for fiscal year 2017 shall be
11 \$851,891,598;

12 (iii) for fiscal year 2018 shall be
13 \$868,077,538;

14 (iv) for fiscal year 2019 shall be
15 \$885,439,089;

16 (v) for fiscal year 2020 shall be
17 \$903,147,870; and

18 (vi) for fiscal year 2021 shall be
19 \$921,210,828; and

20 (C) under title V of this Act—

21 (i) for fiscal year 2016 shall be
22 \$705,380,421;

23 (ii) for fiscal year 2017 shall be
24 \$672,535,002;

1 (iii) for fiscal year 2018 shall be
2 \$685,313,167;

3 (iv) for fiscal year 2019 shall be
4 \$699,019,431;

5 (v) for fiscal year 2020 shall be
6 \$712,999,819; and

7 (vi) for fiscal year 2021 shall be
8 \$727,259,816.

9 (2) DISTRIBUTION.—The cumulative amount
10 authorized for appropriation for a fiscal year under
11 a subparagraph of paragraph (1) shall be distributed
12 among the programs funded pursuant to such sub-
13 paragraph in the ratio that—

14 (A) the amount that this Act would au-
15 thorize for appropriation from the Highway
16 Trust Fund for such a program for such fiscal
17 year if this section were not in effect; bears to

18 (B) the amount that this Act would au-
19 thorize for appropriation from the Highway
20 Trust Fund, if this section were not in effect,
21 for all programs for such fiscal year funded
22 under the title (or titles) specified in such sub-
23 paragraph.

24 (3) OBLIGATION LIMITATION.—The Secretary
25 shall adjust any limitation on obligations for any of

1 fiscal years 2016 through 2021 that applies to pro-
2 grams funded under a title (or titles) specified in a
3 subparagraph of paragraph (1) by an amount equal
4 to—

5 (A) the amount authorized for appropria-
6 tion from the Highway Trust Fund (other than
7 the Mass Transit Account) under that subpara-
8 graph for that fiscal year for those programs;
9 minus

10 (B) the amount that this Act would au-
11 thorize for appropriation from the Highway
12 Trust Fund (other than the Mass Transit Ac-
13 count) for that fiscal year for those programs if
14 this section were not in effect.

15 (b) MASS TRANSIT ACCOUNT.—

16 (1) CUMULATIVE AUTHORIZATION.—Notwith-
17 standing any other provision of this Act, the cumu-
18 lative amount available from the Mass Transit Ac-
19 count of the Highway Trust Fund under title III of
20 this Act—

21 (A) for fiscal year 2016 shall be
22 \$10,307,681,561;

23 (B) for fiscal year 2017 shall be
24 \$10,491,158,452;

1 (C) for fiscal year 2018 shall be
2 \$10,690,490,462;

3 (D) for fiscal year 2019 shall be
4 \$10,904,300,272;

5 (E) for fiscal year 2020 shall be
6 \$11,122,386,277; and

7 (F) for fiscal year 2021 shall be
8 \$11,344,834,003.

9 (2) DISTRIBUTION.—The cumulative amount
10 available for appropriation for a fiscal year under a
11 subparagraph under paragraph (1) shall be distrib-
12 uted among the programs funded pursuant to such
13 subparagraph in the ratio that—

14 (A) the amount that this Act would make
15 available from the Mass Transit Account of the
16 Highway Trust Fund for such a program for
17 such fiscal year if this section were not in ef-
18 fect; bears to

19 (B) the amount that this Act would make
20 available from the Mass Transit Account of the
21 Highway Trust Fund, if this section were not
22 in effect, for all programs for such fiscal year
23 funded under the title (or titles) specified in
24 such subparagraph.

1 (3) OBLIGATION LIMITATION.—The Secretary
2 shall adjust any limitation on obligations for any of
3 fiscal years 2016 or 2017 through 2021 that applies
4 to programs funded under a title specified in a sub-
5 paragraph of paragraph (1) by an amount equal
6 to—

7 (A) the amount made available from the
8 Mass Transit Account of the Highway Trust
9 Fund under that subparagraph for that fiscal
10 year for those programs; minus

11 (B) the amount that this Act would make
12 available from the Mass Transit Account of the
13 Highway Trust Fund for that fiscal year for
14 those programs if this section were not in ef-
15 fect.

16 **SEC. ____ . MODIFICATION OF FURTHER ADDITIONAL**
17 **TRANSFERS TO TRUST FUND.**

18 Section 9503(f)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code of
19 1986, as amended by section 51201 of division E of this
20 Act, is further amended—

21 (1) in subparagraph (A) by striking
22 “\$34,401,000,000” and inserting
23 “\$35,726,000,000”; and

1 (2) in subparagraph (B) by striking
2 “\$11,214,000,000” and inserting “\$9,889,000,000”.
