At the end of subtitle B of title VII, insert the following new section:

1	SEC. 7 EXPANSION OF RECOGNITION BY THE DEFENSE
2	HEALTH AGENCY OF CERTIFYING BODIES
3	FOR PHYSICIANS.
4	(a) Expansion.—Not later than 180 days after the
5	date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the De-
6	fense Health Agency shall revise the policy of the Defense
7	Health Agency regarding the credentialing and privileging
8	under the military health system to expand the recognition
9	of certifying bodies for physicians under such policy to a
10	wide range of additional board certifications in medical
11	specialties and subspecialties. The following certifying
12	bodies shall be so recognized:
13	(1) The member boards of the American Board
14	of Medical Specialties.
15	(2) The Bureau of Osteopathic Specialists of
16	the American Osteopathic Association.
17	(3) The American Board of Foot and Ankle
18	Surgery.

1	(4) The American Board of Podiatric Medicine.
2	(5) The American Board of Oral and Maxillo-
3	facial Surgery.
4	(b) Standards for Recognition of Other Cer-
5	TIFYING BODIES.—To be recognized under subsection (a),
6	a certifying body shall—
7	(1) be an organization described in section
8	501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and
9	exempt from taxation under section 501(a) of that
10	Code;
11	(2) maintain a process to define, periodically re-
12	view, enforce, and update specific standards regard-
13	ing knowledge and skills of the specialty or sub-
14	specialty;
15	(3) administer a psychometrically valid assess-
16	ment to determine whether a physician meets stand-
17	ards for initial certification, recertification, or con-
18	tinuing certification;
19	(4) establish and enforce a code of professional
20	conduct; and
21	(5) require that, in order to be considered a
22	board certified specialty physician, a physician must
23	satisfy—
24	(A) the certifying body's applicable re-
25	quirements for initial certification: and

1	(B) any applicable recertification or con-
2	tinuing certification requirements of the certi-
3	fying body that granted the initial certification.
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
