AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8 OFFERED BY MR. WHITESIDES OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle C of title II, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 2 REPORT ON RESEARCH RELATING TO THE
2	UPPER ATMOSPHERE AND NEAR-SPACE ENVI-
3	RONMENT.
4	(a) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
5	gress that—
6	(1) the upper atmosphere and near-space envi-
7	ronment are important to Air Force and Joint oper-
8	ations worldwide and the operational and threat en-
9	vironments that U.S. assets are likely to encounter;
10	(2) research is needed to study atmospheric
11	phenomenology and develop technologies for contin-
12	uous monitoring and detection of encroachment and
13	adversarial effects in the atmosphere;
14	(3) research on atmospheric signatures and dy-
15	namics in the upper atmosphere and the develop-
16	ment of predictive techniques to ensure observational
17	and operational superiority would be beneficial for
18	Air Force missions; and

1	(4) the Secretary of the Air Force should con-
2	duct additional research in these areas.
3	(b) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
4	of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense,
5	in consultation with the Secretary of the Air Force, shall
6	submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the Sen-
7	ate and the House of Representatives a report that in-
8	cludes the following:
9	(1) An assessment of intelligence activities and
10	other competitive activities undertaken by foreign
11	nations with respect to the upper atmosphere and
12	near-space environment.
13	(2) A comprehensive strategy to address the
14	upper atmosphere and near-space environment,
15	which shall include requirements for high-altitude,
16	long-duration, and heavy-lift propulsion systems and
17	platforms.
