

**AMENDMENT TO H. CON. RES. 71, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. GROTHMAN OF WISCONSIN**

Amend section 201 (relating to reconciliation in the House of Representatives) to read as follows:

1 **SEC. 201. RECONCILIATION IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENT-**
2 **ATIVES.**

3 (a) SUBMISSIONS PROVIDING FOR RECONCILI-
4 ATION.—Not later than October 6, 2017, the committees
5 named in subsection (b) shall submit their recommenda-
6 tions on changes in laws within their jurisdictions to the
7 Committee on the Budget that would achieve the specified
8 reduction in the deficit for the period of fiscal years 2018
9 through 2027.

10 (b) INSTRUCTIONS.—

11 (1) COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE.—The Com-
12 mittee on Agriculture shall submit changes in laws
13 within its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the deficit
14 by \$20,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years
15 2018 through 2027.

16 (2) COMMITTEE ON ARMED SERVICES.—The
17 Committee on Armed Services shall submit changes
18 in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the

1 deficit by \$2,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal
2 years 2018 through 2027.

3 (3) COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND THE
4 WORKFORCE.—The Committee on Education and
5 the Workforce shall submit changes in laws within
6 its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the deficit by
7 \$40,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2018
8 through 2027.

9 (4) COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND COMMERCE.—
10 The Committee on Energy and Commerce shall sub-
11 mit changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient
12 to reduce the deficit by \$40,000,000,000 for the pe-
13 riod of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

14 (5) COMMITTEE ON FINANCIAL SERVICES.—The
15 Committee on Financial Services shall submit
16 changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to
17 reduce the deficit by \$28,000,000,000 for the period
18 of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

19 (6) COMMITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY.—
20 The Committee on Homeland Security shall submit
21 changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to
22 reduce the deficit by \$6,000,000,000 for the period
23 of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

24 (7) COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY.—The
25 Committee on the Judiciary shall submit changes in

1 laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the
2 deficit by \$90,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal
3 years 2018 through 2027.

4 (8) COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES.—
5 The Committee on Natural Resources shall submit
6 changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to
7 reduce the deficit by \$10,000,000,000 for the period
8 of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

9 (9) COMMITTEE ON OVERSIGHT AND GOVERN-
10 MENT REFORM.—The Committee on Oversight and
11 Government Reform shall submit changes in laws
12 within its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the deficit
13 by \$64,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years
14 2018 through 2027.

15 (10) COMMITTEE ON VETERANS' AFFAIRS.—
16 The Committee on Veterans' Affairs shall submit
17 changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to
18 reduce the deficit by \$2,000,000,000 for the period
19 of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

20 (11) COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS.—The
21 Committee on Ways and Means shall submit
22 changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to
23 reduce the deficit by \$104,000,000,000 for the pe-
24 riod of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.
