At the end of subtitle C of title XIII, add the following:

1	SEC. 13 INDEPENDENT STUDY ON HUMAN RIGHTS
2	ABUSES RELATED TO THE ARMS EXPORTS OF
3	THE TOP FIVE ARMS-EXPORTING FOREIGN
4	COUNTRIES.
5	(a) In General.—The Secretary of State, in coordi-
6	nation with the Defense Security Cooperation Agency, the
7	National Security Council, the Secretary of Defense, and
8	the Secretary of Commerce, shall enter into an agreement
9	to provide for the conduct of an independent study on
10	human rights abuses related to the arms exports of the
11	top five arms-exporting foreign countries, including China
12	and Russia.
13	(b) Matters to Be Included.—The study de-
14	scribed in subsection (a)—
15	(1) shall provide recommendations to reduce ci-
16	vilian harm in foreign countries that may have oc-
17	curred directly or indirectly in connection with such
18	arms exports, including—

1	(A) strategies to work with partner na-
2	tions; and
3	(B) complementary or additional engage-
4	ment, including with capabilities;
5	(2) shall analyze how to reduce risk relating to
6	such arms exports, including through use of addi-
7	tional training, tools, and data; and
8	(3) may include other relevant elements.
9	(c) Deadline.—
10	(1) In general.—The study described in sub-
11	section (a) shall be completed by September 1, 2022
12	and shall be submitted to the appropriate congres-
13	sional committees not later than 5 days after its
14	completion.
15	(2) Appropriate congressional commit-
16	TEES DEFINED.—In this subsection, the term "ap-
17	propriate congressional committees" means—
18	(A) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and
19	the Committee on Armed Services of the House
20	of Representatives; and
21	(B) the Committee on Foreign Relations
22	and the Committee on Armed Services of the
23	Senate.
