

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117–13
OFFERED BY MS. WILD OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the end of subtitle C of title XIII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 1325. ANNUAL REPORT ON UNITED STATES STRATEGY**
2 **TO COUNTER MALIGN FOREIGN INFLUENCE**
3 **IN AFRICA.**

4 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 120 days
5 after the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually
6 thereafter for 5 years, the Secretary of State, in consulta-
7 tion with the heads of other Federal departments and
8 agencies as appropriate, shall submit to the appropriate
9 committees a report on the United States strategy and
10 associated efforts to counter the malign influence of the
11 People’s Republic of China, the Russian Federation, and
12 other foreign actors who seek to undermine United States
13 efforts and influence in Africa.

14 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required by subsection
15 (a) shall include the following:

16 (1) An assessment of the scope and nature of
17 foreign malign influence in Africa, including malign
18 influence that is facilitated by the People’s Republic
19 of China, the Russian Federation, and other actors.

1 (2) A detailed account of United States foreign
2 assistance and other initiatives developed and imple-
3 mented during fiscal years 2018, 2019, 2020, and
4 2021 to address foreign malign influence in Africa,
5 including those programs designed to build foreign
6 government and civil society capacity to improve
7 standards related to human rights, labor, anti-cor-
8 ruption, fiscal transparency, and other tenets of
9 good governance.

10 (3) Analysis of policy and programmatic limita-
11 tions, gaps, and resource requirements to meet re-
12 lated strategic objectives.

13 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
14 shall be submitted in unclassified form but may contain
15 a classified annex.

16 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
17 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-
18 gressional committees” means—

19 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
20 House of Representatives; and

21 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations of the
22 Senate.
