

AMENDMENT TO COMMITTEE PRINT 117-13
OFFERED BY MS. WILLIAMS OF GEORGIA

At the end of subtitle E of title VIII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 8 ____ . CHILD CARE RESOURCE GUIDE.**

2 The Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 631 et seq.) is
3 amended—

4 (1) by redesignating section 49 as section 50;

5 and

6 (2) by inserting after section 48 the following
7 new section:

8 **“SEC. 49. CHILD CARE RESOURCE GUIDE.**

9 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
10 date of the enactment of this section and not less fre-
11 quently than every 5 years thereafter, the Administrator
12 shall publish or update a resource guide, applicable to var-
13 ious business models as determined by the Administrator,
14 for small business concerns operating as child care pro-
15 viders.

16 “(b) GUIDANCE ON SMALL BUSINESS CONCERN
17 MATTERS.—The resource guide required under subsection
18 (a) shall include guidance for such small business concerns
19 related to—

1 “(1) operations (including marketing and man-
2 agement planning);

3 “(2) finances (including financial planning, fi-
4 nancing, payroll, and insurance);

5 “(3) compliance with relevant laws (including
6 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and this Act);

7 “(4) training and safety (including equipment
8 and materials);

9 “(5) quality (including eligibility for funding
10 under the Child Care and Development Block Grant
11 Act of 1990 as an eligible child care provider); and

12 “(6) any other matters the Administrator deter-
13 mines appropriate.

14 “(c) CONSULTATION REQUIRED.—Before publication
15 or update of the resource guide required under subsection
16 (a), the Administrator shall consult with the following:

17 “(1) The Secretary of Health and Human Serv-
18 ices.

19 “(2) Representatives from lead agencies des-
20 ignated under section 658D of the Child Care and
21 Development Block Grant Act of 1990.

22 “(3) Representatives from local or regional
23 child care resource and referral organizations de-
24 scribed in section 658E(c)(3)(B)(iii)(I) of the Child
25 Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990.

1 “(4) Any other relevant entities as determined
2 by the Administrator.

3 “(d) PUBLICATION AND DISSEMINATION RE-
4 QUIRED.—

5 “(1) PUBLICATION.—The Administrator shall
6 publish the resource guide required under subsection
7 (a) in English and in the 10 most commonly spoken
8 languages, other than English, in the United States,
9 which shall include Mandarin, Cantonese, Japanese,
10 and Korean. The Administrator shall make each
11 translation of the resource guide available on a pub-
12 licly accessible website of the Administration.

13 “(2) DISTRIBUTION.—

14 “(A) ADMINISTRATOR.—The Adminis-
15 trator shall distribute the resource guide re-
16 quired under subsection (a) to offices within the
17 Administration, including district offices, and to
18 the persons consulted under subsection (c).

19 “(B) OTHER ENTITIES.—Women’s busi-
20 ness centers (as described under section 29),
21 small business development centers, chapters of
22 the Service Corps of Retired Executives (estab-
23 lished under section 8(b)(1)(B)), and Veteran
24 Business Outreach Centers (as described under
25 section 32) shall distribute to small business

1 concerns operating as child care providers, sole
2 proprietors operating as child care providers,
3 and child care providers that have limited ad-
4 ministrative capacity, as determined by the Ad-
5 ministrator—

6 “(i) the resource guide required under
7 subsection (a); and

8 “(ii) other resources available that the
9 Administrator determines to be relevant.”.
