**OFFERED BY MR. WILSON OF SOUTH CAROLINA**

At the end of subtitle A of title XVIII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_.** **DETERMINATION OF SANCTIONS FOR HONG**  
2 **KONG OFFICIALS ENGAGED IN POLITICAL**  
3 **PERSECUTION.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 90 days of enact-  
5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of State, in consultation  
6 with the Secretary of the Treasury, shall submit to the  
7 appropriate congressional committees a determination on  
8 whether reasonable grounds exist for concluding that each  
9 person described in subsection (b)—

10 (1) has engaged in any of the conduct described  
11 in the Hong Kong Autonomy Act (Public Law 116-  
12 149; 22 U.S.C. 5701 note), Hong Kong Human  
13 Rights and Democracy Act (Public Law 116-76; 22  
14 U.S.C. 5701 note), or Executive Order 13936 (85  
15 Fed. Reg. 43413; 22 U.S.C. 5701 note); and

16 (2) otherwise meets criteria for imposition of  
17 sanctions under these authorities.

1 (b) PERSONS DESCRIBED.—The persons described in  
2 this section are the following:

6           (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-  
7           FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-  
8           sional committees” means—

9           (1) the Committee on Foreign Relations, the  
10          Committee on Armed Services, the Committee on  
11          Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs, the Com-  
12          mittee on Homeland Security and Governmental Af-  
13          fairs, and the Committee on the Judiciary of the  
14          Senate; and

15          (2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs, the  
16          Committee on Armed Services, the Committee on Fi-  
17          nancial Services, the Committee on Homeland Secu-  
18          rity, and the Committee on the Judiciary of the  
19          House of Representatives.
