At the end of title III, add the following:

1 SEC. ____. REVIEW OF INFORMATION RELATED TO FUND 2 ING OPPORTUNITIES UNDER PROGRAMS AD 3 MINISTERED BY SAMHSA.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than one year after the 5 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and 6 Human Services (referred to in this section as the "Secretary") shall convene a public meeting for purposes of 7 improving awareness of, and access to, information related 8 to current and future funding opportunities under pro-9 10 grams administered by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (in this section referred 11 12 to as "SAMHSA funding opportunities").

13 (b) TOPICS.—The public meeting under subsection14 (a) shall include—

15 (1) opportunities to improve the utility and 16 functionality of internet websites maintained by the 17 Secretary that provide information related to 18 SAMHSA funding opportunities, such as 19 Grants.gov;

(2) other models for displaying and dissemi nating information related to SAMHSA funding op portunities, such as interactive dashboards; and

4 (3) strategies to improve the ability of entities
5 to apply for SAMHSA funding opportunities, includ6 ing entities that have not traditionally applied for
7 SAMHSA funding opportunities.

8 (c) WEBSITE IMPROVEMENTS.—The Secretary shall 9 implement improvements to Grants.gov related to 10 SAMHSA funding opportunities based on stakeholder 11 feedback received at the public meeting under subsection 12 (a), as appropriate, to the maximum extent feasible.

13 (d) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date 14 on which the public meeting under subsection (a) is con-15 vened, the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions of the Senate and 16 the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House 17 of Representatives a report summarizing the findings of 18 19 such meeting, including how the Secretary has taken into 20account the feedback received through such meeting and 21 implemented-

(1) improvements to internet websites maintained by the Secretary that provide information related to SAMHSA funding opportunities; and
