

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-54**

**OFFERED BY MR. WITTMAN OF VIRGINIA**

At the end of subtitle E of title XII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . REPORT ON FUTURE GLOBAL FORCE POSTURE**

2 **RAMIFICATIONS.**

3 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days  
5 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-  
6 retary of Defense, in consultation with the Com-  
7 mander of the United States Indo-Pacific Command,  
8 the Commander of the United States European  
9 Command, and Commander of the United States  
10 Transportation Command, the Director of the De-  
11 fense Logistics Agency, and other Federal official  
12 that the Secretary determines to be appropriate,  
13 shall submit to the appropriate congressional com-  
14 mittees a report that describes what impact, if any,  
15 the following force commitments in Europe will have  
16 on ability of the United States to increase its pres-  
17 ence the Indo-Pacific:

18 (A) Increased United States force presence  
19 in Europe since February 1, 2022.

1 (B) Establishment of a permanent troop  
2 presence in Poland.

3 (C) Enhanced rotational deployments in  
4 the Baltic region.

5 (D) Any other force deployment decisions  
6 the Secretary considers appropriate.

7 (2) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report  
8 required by paragraph (1) shall also include the fol-  
9 lowing:

10 (A) An assessment of any impacts to the  
11 posture and capabilities of the current strategic  
12 force laydown of the United States Indo-Pacific  
13 Command, importantly including capabilities  
14 such as—

15 (i) logistics and sustainment capabili-  
16 ties, including positioning, quantity, and  
17 distribution of fuels; and

18 (ii) munitions required to meet oper-  
19 ational requirements.

20 (B) A detailed assessment of any decisions  
21 made to prioritize the United States European  
22 Command over other commands, including the  
23 United States Indo-Pacific Command.

24 (C) An assessment of the costs associated  
25 with any measures required to meet any antici-

1           pated new or emerging requirements in the  
2           United States European Command anticipated  
3           through December 31, 2025.

4           (b) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)  
5 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include  
6 a classified annex.

7           (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—  
8 In this section, the term “appropriate congressional de-  
9 fense committees” means—

- 10           (1) the congressional defense committees; and  
11           (2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the  
12           House of Representatives and the Committee on  
13           Foreign Relations of the Senate.
