OFFERED BY MRS. MCIVER OF NEW JERSEY

Insert, at the appropriate place, the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . PROTECT WORLD CUP ATTENDEES.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
3 sion of law, an entity receiving Federal funds under this
4 Act or under section 90005(a)(1)(B) or section
5 90005(a)(1)(C) of an Act to provide for reconciliation pur-
6 suant to title II of H. Con. Res. 14 (Public Law 119–
7 21) may not, except under exigent circumstances—

8 (1) participate in any program under section
9 287(g) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
10 U.S.C. 1357(g)), or

11 (2) carry out any civil immigration enforcement
12 activity under the immigration laws (as such term is
13 defined in section 101 of the Immigration and Na-
14 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101)),
15 during the covered time period.

16 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

17 (1) COVERED TIME PERIOD.—The term “cov-
18 ered time period” means the period of time begin-
19 ning at 12:01 a.m. on June 11, 2026, and con-
20 cluding at 11:59 p.m. on July 19, 2026.

1 (2) EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES DEFINED.—The
2 term “exigent circumstances” means a situation in-
3 volving any of the following:

4 (A) The imminent risk of death, violence,
5 or physical harm to a person, including in the
6 case of terrorism (as such term is defined in
7 section 2 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
8 (6 U.S.C. 101)).

9 (B) The imminent risk to the national se-
10 curity of the United States.

11 (C) The immediate arrest or hot pursuit of
12 an individual presenting an imminent risk to
13 public safety, including relating to death, vio-
14 lence, or physical harm to a person.

15 (D) The imminent risk of destruction of
16 evidence that is material to an ongoing criminal
17 case.
