## AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT OF H.R. 1960

## OFFERED BY MR. WALZ OF MINNESOTA

At the end of subtitle C of title V, add the following new section:

## 1 SEC. 5\_\_\_\_\_. TWO-YEAR MORATORIUM ON SEPARATION OF 2 MEMBERS FROM THE ARMED FORCES ON 3 THE BASIS OF A PERSONALITY DISORDER OR 4 ADJUSTMENT DISORDER.

5 (a) MORATORIUM.—During the two-year period be-6 ginning on the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of a military department may not separate a mem-7 ber of the Armed Forces under the jurisdiction of that 8 9 Secretary from the Armed Forces due of unfitness for 10 duty because of a mental condition not amounting to dis-11 ability, including separation on the basis of a personality 12 disorder or adjustment disorder.

(b) NO IMPACT ON OTHER SEPARATION METHODS.—The moratorium imposed by subsection (a) shall
not be construed to affect the authority of the Secretary
of a military department to retire or separate a member
of the Armed Forces for disability under chapter 61 of
title 10, United States Code, or other provision of law.

(c) EXCEPTION FOR SEPARATION DURING FIRST
 SIX-MONTHS OF SERVICE.—The moratorium imposed by
 subsection (a) shall not apply to any member of the Armed
 Forces during the first 180 days of service of the member
 on active duty.
