

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. WILSON OF SOUTH CAROLINA

Page 1057, after line 8, insert the following (and re-designate accordingly):

1 (b) **CERTIFICATION REQUIRED.**—Not later than 30
2 days after the submission of each report required by sub-
3 section (a), the President shall certify to the appropriate
4 congressional committees whether there may be reasonable
5 grounds to determine that any individuals and entities in-
6 cluded in the list described in subsection (a)(4) have en-
7 gaged in any of the conduct described in subsection (a)(2)
8 or subsection (a)(3).

9 (c) **EFFECT OF POSITIVE CERTIFICATION.**—If the
10 President makes an affirmative certification under sub-
11 section (b) with respect to a foreign person, the President
12 shall impose applicable sanctions with respect to each such
13 person pursuant to the authorities and procedures set
14 forth in the applicable regulations under—

15 (1) part 583 of title 31, Code of Federal Regu-
16 lations (relating to sanctions authorized under the
17 Global Magnitsky Human Rights Accountability Act
18 (22 U.S.C. 10101 et seq.);

1 (2) part 589 of title 31, Code of Federal Regu-
2 lations (relating to Ukraine-/Russia-related sanc-
3 tions);

4 (3) part 587 of title 31, Code of Federal Regu-
5 lations (relating to Russian Harmful Foreign Activi-
6 ties sanctions); or

7 (4) any other regulation under chapter V of
8 title 31, Code of Federal Regulations, providing for
9 the imposition of sanctions (including the blocking of
10 property or interests in property) with respect to the
11 conduct for which such person received an affirma-
12 tive certification.

13 (d) EFFECT OF SUBSEQUENT NEGATIVE DETER-
14 MINATION.—To the extent that the President determines,
15 based on a subsequent report required by subsection (a),
16 that an individual or entity previously listed in such a re-
17 port no longer engages in any of the conduct described
18 in subsection (b) or otherwise no longer meets the require-
19 ments with respect to the applicable sanctions imposed
20 with respect to such person under subsection (c), the
21 President may waive or terminate such sanctions with re-
22 spect to such person.
