At the end of title VI of the committee print, insert the following:

1	SEC. 612. CENTRAL BERING SEA POTENTIAL PLACES OF
2	REFUGE.
3	To enhance safety of life at sea and protection of the
4	marine environment in the Central Bering Sea, the Com-
5	mandant of the Coast Guard shall—
6	(1) conduct a study to review locations in the
7	Bering Sea that—
8	(A) have the least amount of winter sea ice
9	and are close in proximity to major fishery and
10	fishery conservation activities; and
11	(B) can serve as primary or alternate
12	places of refuge throughout the year in accord-
13	ance with the National Response Plan Guide-
14	lines for Places of Refuge Decisionmaking;
15	(2) not later than 1 year after the date of en-
16	actment of this Act, consult with appropriate State
17	and Federal agency officials to determine the im-
18	provements necessary to ensure that harbor facilities

1	at the locations described in paragraph (1) are func-
2	tional, including improvements that may qualify the
3	harbors to be designated as a potential place of ref-
4	uge, or as an alternate place of refuge, throughout
5	the year in case of a marine casualty or for the re-
6	sponse to or prevention of environmental damage or
7	the threat of environmental damage; and
8	(3) not later than 2 years after the date of en-
9	actment of this Act—
10	(A) consult with appropriate Federal agen-
11	cies on a plan to identify the steps required to
12	complete the improvements identified under
13	paragraph (2); and
14	(B) submit the plan to Congress.
