

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 115-70**  
**OFFERED BY MR. KHANNA OF CALIFORNIA**

Add at the end of subtitle F of title XII the following:

1 **SEC. 12 \_\_\_\_ . INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE IF COALITION**  
2 **PARTNERS OR UNITED STATES MILITARY OR**  
3 **INTELLIGENCE PERSONNEL VIOLATED FED-**  
4 **ERAL LAW OR DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE**  
5 **POLICY WHILE CONDUCTING OPERATIONS IN**  
6 **YEMEN.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall  
8 conduct an investigation to determine if coalition partners  
9 of the United States or members of the Armed Forces or  
10 intelligence personnel violated Federal law, the laws of  
11 armed conflict, or Department of Defense policy while con-  
12 ducting operations in Yemen.

13 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The investigation  
14 required under subsection (a) shall also seek to determine  
15 the following:

16 (1) Whether any Armed Forces or intelligence  
17 personnel interrogated Yemeni citizens in prisons  
18 within Yemen or provided questions to foreign per-  
19 sonnel for use in such interrogations, and whether

1 such interrogations or actions were consistent with  
2 United States law and policy.

3 (2) Whether any Armed Forces or intelligence  
4 personnel violated the prohibitions of section 362 of  
5 title 10, United States Code, while conducting oper-  
6 ations in Yemen.

7 (3) Whether any United States coalition part-  
8 ners committed gross violations of internationally  
9 recognized human rights while conducting operations  
10 in Yemen that would make such coalition partners  
11 ineligible for any training, equipment, or other as-  
12 sistance for a unit of a foreign security force under  
13 section 362 of title 10, United States Code.

14 (4) Whether a waiver or exception has been  
15 granted to United States coalition partners under  
16 section 362 of title 10, United States Code, while  
17 conducting operations in Yemen.

18 (c) REPORT.—

19 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 120 days  
20 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-  
21 retary of Defense shall submit to the Committee on  
22 Armed Services of the Senate and the Committee on  
23 Armed Services of the House of Representatives a  
24 report that contains the findings of the investigation  
25 required under this section.

1           (2) FORM.—The report required under this sec-  
2           tion shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may  
3           contain a classified annex

4           (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this subsection:

5           (1) COALITION PARTNERS.—The term “coali-  
6           tion partners” has the meaning given such term in  
7           paragraph (3) of section 948a of title 10, United  
8           States Code.

9           (2) GROSS VIOLATIONS OF INTERNATIONALLY  
10          RECOGNIZED HUMAN RIGHTS.—The term “gross vio-  
11          lations of internationally recognized human rights”  
12          has the meaning given such term in subsection  
13          (d)(1) of section 502B of the Foreign Assistance Act  
14          of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2304).
