

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119–8
OFFERED BY MR. STEUBE OF FLORIDA

At the end of subtitle B of title XII, add the following:

1 SEC. 12_. REPORT ON U.S.-ISRAEL MILITARY EXERCISES.

2 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
3 gress that—

4 (1) conducting regular military exercises of in-
5 creasing complexity with the State of Israel that in-
6 volve air, sea, ground, space, and cyberspace forces
7 supports the national security interests of the
8 United States;

9 (2) these military exercises should include other
10 regional partners as well when feasible; and

11 (3) these military exercises strengthen the read-
12 iness of U.S. forces and those of our partners, bol-
13 ster their ability to operate together, reinforce deter-
14 rence, and support regional security.

15 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
16 of the enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter for
17 a period not to exceed 3 years, the Secretary of Defense
18 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-
19 port that includes the following:

1 (1) A list of Department of Defense exercises
2 that included Israel over the previous 12 months.

3 (2) A detailed description of—

4 (A) the capabilities and missions rehearsed
5 in each exercise;

6 (B) how each exercise rehearsed new or
7 more challenging combat capabilities and sce-
8 narios;

9 (C) how each exercise improved the readi-
10 ness and capabilities of participating militaries
11 and strengthened their ability to operate to-
12 gether; and

13 (D) the resources that would be needed to
14 conduct more frequent and beneficial U.S.-
15 Israel military exercises.

16 (3) A plan to increase the complexity of exer-
17 cises and invite other regional partners to partici-
18 pate.

19 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (b)
20 shall be in written form and transmitted in an unclassified
21 manner and may contain a classified annex.
