AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119–8 OFFERED BY MR. STEUBE OF FLORIDA

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following:

SEC. 12 BRIEFING ON EXPEDITING ARMS TRANSFERS
TO ISRAEL.
(a) In General.—Not later than 90 days after the
date of enactment of this Act, and every 180 days there-
after for a period not to exceed 3 years, the Secretary of
State, in coordination with Secretary of Defense, shall
brief the appropriate congressional committees on the sta-
tus of deliveries to the Government of Israel of any mili-
tary aircraft or air-launched munitions approved for trans-
fer that are undelivered or partially delivered.
(b) Contents of Briefing.—The briefing de-
scribed in subsection (a) shall include—
(1) the estimated delivery timetable and any on-
going or potential measures associated with the
items, including advance training and integration
challenges;
(2) specific reasons for any delay related to the
United States Government, defense suppliers, or a
foreign government;

1	(3) the feasibility and advisability of providing
2	the State of Israel an interim capability;
3	(4) what measures are being taken or could be
4	taken to expedite delivery to Israel; and
5	(5) authorities or appropriations that Congress
6	could provide to expedite the delivery.
7	(c) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-
8	FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-
9	sional committees" means the congressional defense com-
10	mittees, the Committee on Foreign Affairs in the House
11	of Representatives, and the Committee on Foreign Rela-
12	tions in the Senate.
13	(d) Military Aircraft Defined.—In this section,
14	the term "military aircraft" means aircraft and related
15	articles in 22 CFR 121.10, Category VIII—Aircraft and
16	Related Articles, subsection (a).
