AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1217, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. PALLONE OF NEW JERSEY

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

14	tute, some community-based diabetes prevention pro-

17	(4) according to the Centers for Disease Con-
18	trol and Prevention, chronic diseases consume an es-
19	timated 75 percent of health care expenditures each
20	vear cost employers \$1685 for each employee and
