Add at the end the following new title:

3	SEC. 301. CHANGE OF FISCAL YEAR.
4	(a) In General.—
5	(1) Change of Calendar Period.—Section
6	1102 of title 31, United States Code, is amended—
7	(A) by striking "October 1" and inserting
8	"January 1"; and
9	(B) by striking "September 30 of the fol-
10	lowing year" and inserting "December 31 of
11	that year".
12	(2) Effective date.—The amendments made
13	by paragraph (1) shall be effective on January 1,
14	2021.
15	(b) Transition to New Fiscal Year.—
16	(1) Transition period budget.—As soon as
17	practicable, the President shall prepare and submit
18	to Congress—

1	(A) after consultation with the Committees
2	on the Budget and the Committees on Appro-
3	priations of the House of Representatives and
4	the Senate, budget estimates for the Federal
5	Government for the period commencing October
6	1, 2020, and ending on December 31, 2020, in
7	such form and detail as the President may de-
8	termine; and
9	(B) proposed legislation the President con-
10	siders appropriate with respect to changes in
11	law necessary to provide authorizations of ap-
12	propriations for that period.
13	(2) Agency transition.—The Director of the
14	Office of Management and Budget shall provide by
15	regulation, order, or otherwise for the orderly transi-
16	tion by all departments, agencies, and instrumental-
17	ities of the Federal government and the government
18	of the District of Columbia from the use of the fiscal
19	year in effect on the date of the enactment of this
20	Act to the use of the new fiscal year prescribed in
21	subsection (a). The Director shall prepare and sub-
22	mit to Congress such additional proposed legislation
23	as the Director considers necessary to accomplish
24	this objective.

1	(c) Conversion of Authorizations of Appro-
2	PRIATIONS.—Any law providing for an authorization of
3	appropriations commencing on October 1 of a year shall,
4	if that year is any year after 2019, be considered as mean-
5	ing January 1 of the following year. Any law providing
6	for an authorization of appropriations ending on Sep-
7	tember 30 of a year shall, if that year is any year after
8	2019, be considered as meaning December 31 of that year.
9	Any law providing for an authorization of appropriations
10	for the fiscal year 2021 or any fiscal year thereafter shall
11	be construed as referring to that fiscal year ending on De-
12	cember 31 of the calendar year having the same calendar
13	year number as the fiscal year number.
14	(d) TITLE OF APPROPRIATION ACTS.—
15	(1) In general.—Section 105 of title 1,
16	United States Code, is amended by striking "Sep-
17	tember 30" and inserting "December 31".
18	(2) Effective date.—The amendment made
19	by paragraph (1) shall be effective for any fiscal
20	year commencing on or after January 1, 2021.
21	(e) Conforming Amendments.—The Congressional
22	Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 is amend-
23	ed—
24	(1) in section 202(e)—
25	(A) in paragraph (1)—

1	(i) by striking "February 15 of each
2	year" and inserting "February 1 of each
3	calendar year''; and
4	(ii) by striking "October 1 of that
5	year" and inserting "January 1 of the next
6	calendar year''; and
7	(B) in paragraph (3)—
8	(i) by striking "September 30" each
9	place it appears and inserting "December
10	31"; and
11	(ii) by striking "October 1 of that cal-
12	endar year" and inserting "January 1 of
13	the next calendar year".
