12	(c) OIG INVESTIGATION.—The Inspector General of
13	the Department of Health and Human Services shall con-
14	duct an investigation of all claims described in subsection
15	(b)(1) that resulted in a prescription for durable medical
16	equipment and that are identified pursuant to the report

- 1 submitted under subsection (b) as not being medically nec-
- 2 essary. Based on such investigation, the Inspector General
- 3 shall submit recommendations to the Centers for Medicare
- 4 & Medicaid Services on how to identify and address fraud-
- 5 ulent claims under the Medicare program for telehealth
- 6 services that are furnished via an audio-only communica-
- 7 tions system and result in a prescription for durable med-
- 8 ical equipment.
