7 (b) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 9 months after 8 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Committee on 9 House Administration of the House of Representatives, the Committee on Rules and Administration of the Senate, 10 11 and the head of each other office of the legislative branch 12 shall prescribe regulations governing the application of 13 section 6329 of title 5, United States Code, including the certification requirement under subsection (c) of such sec-14 15 tion, to employees of the House of Representatives, em-16 ployees of the Senate, and employees of such office, re-17 spectively.

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
