

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 115–70**  
**OFFERED BY MR. BRENDAN F. BOYLE OF**  
**PENNSYLVANIA**

At the end of subtitle E of title XII, add the following new section:

**1 SEC. 12\_. SENSE OF CONGRESS AND CONGRESSIONAL**  
**2 BRIEFING ON NORTH KOREAN**  
**3 DENUCLEARIZATION EFFORTS.**

**4 (a) FINDINGS.**—Congress finds the following:

**5 (1)** House Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy  
**6** stated in the Washington Post on July 1, 2015, that  
**7** sanctions against Iran should be lifted only if the  
**8** Iranians cease their regional aggression and terrorist  
**9** activities. He further stated: “Promising Iran relief  
**10** from sanctions that aren’t related to its nuclear pro-  
**11** gram would remove all leverage to enforce Iranian  
**12** compliance and punish the regime for abhorrent  
**13** human rights abuses and global acts of terrorism.”.

**14 (2)** House Majority Leader McCarthy further  
**15** stated: “International inspectors must have ‘any-  
**16** where, anytime’ access to the Iranian sites they need  
**17** to visit, including military and other sensitive facili-  
**18** ties. The Iranian regime’s refusal to submit to intru-

1       sive inspections would be a telling indicator that it  
2       intends to continue its deception.”.

3           (3) The Democratic People’s Republic of Korea  
4       (North Korea) has a history of cheating on nuclear  
5       accords.

6           (4) The United Nations Commission of Inquiry  
7       on Human Rights in North Korea concluded in 2014  
8       that Kim Jong Un and the North Korean leadership  
9       was perpetrating “unspeakable atrocities” against  
10      its own people on a vast scale and committed “wide-  
11      spread, systematic, and gross violations” that  
12      amount to crimes against humanity.

13          (5) The chair of the United Nations Commis-  
14      sion of Inquiry on Human Rights in North Korea  
15      called these atrocities “strikingly similar” to crimes  
16      committed by Nazi Germany in World War II, in-  
17      cluding execution, enslavement, starvation, rape, and  
18      forced abortion, and warned Kim Jong Un of his  
19      own personal culpability in a special letter attached  
20      to the report.

21          (6) Under Kim Jong Un’s leadership, there are  
22      reports of newborn babies in prison being fed to  
23      guard dogs, punishment and possible execution of  
24      starving prisoners caught digging for edible plants,  
25      and forced abortions.

1           (7) Kim Jong Un, after taking over the leader-  
2           ship of North Korea, launched political purges, en-  
3           compassing relatives, including his uncle and half-  
4           brother, who was murdered by a chemical weapon in  
5           Malaysia in 2017.

6           (8) Otto Warmbier, a 22-year-old American col-  
7           lege student, was brutally tortured by the North Ko-  
8           rean regime under Kim Jong Un and died shortly  
9           after his release from North Korea.

10          (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-  
11       gress that the President should seek to ensure that—

12               (1) the requirement of “anytime, anywhere” ac-  
13               cess and inspections of sites relating to North Ko-  
14               rea’s nuclear program is included in any agreement  
15               with North Korea regarding North Korean  
16               denuclearization efforts; and

17               (2) North Korea’s ballistic missile program and  
18               human rights abuses should be addressed in the con-  
19               text of bilateral and multilateral negotiations seeking  
20               to conclude any such agreement with North Korea.

21          (c) CONGRESSIONAL BRIEFING.—Not later than 7  
22       days after the date on which a meeting between the Presi-  
23       dent and North Korean leader Kim Jong Un takes place,  
24       the President shall provide a briefing to the appropriate

1 congressional committees on progress regarding North  
2 Korean denuclearization efforts.

3 (d) DEFINITION.—In subsection (c), the term “ap-  
4 propriate congressional committees” means—

5 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the  
6 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate; and

7 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the  
8 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-  
9 resentatives.
