

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
119–22
OFFERED BY MRS. McCLAIN DELANEY OF
MARYLAND

At the end of subtitle A, of title IV, add the following:

1 **SEC. 4114. CONDITIONAL RESTORATION OF CERTAIN PRO-**
2 **VISIONS OF LAW APPLICABLE TO THE SUP-**
3 **PLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PRO-**
4 **GRAM.**

5 Sections 10101 through 10108, and the amendments
6 made by such sections, of Public Law 119–21 are re-
7 pealed, and the provisions of law amended by such sections
8 are restored as if such sections had not been enacted into
9 law, until the Administrator of the Food and Nutrition
10 Service and the Administrator of the Economic Research
11 Service of the Department of Agriculture, and all State
12 agencies (as defined in section 3 of the Food and Nutrition
13 Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2012)), issue reports evaluating
14 and certifying that any changes made by such sections
15 10101 through 10108, and the amendments made by such
16 sections, to the supplemental nutrition assistance program
17 will not result in—

1 (1) a decrease in benefits to individuals who are
2 part of households with children under the age of
3 18, or

4 (2) a decrease in participation due to changes
5 in eligibility impacting individuals who are part of
6 households with children under the age of 18, in
7 comparison to what would have occurred in the ab-
8 sence of enactment of such sections 10101 through
9 10108, and the amendments made by such sections.
