15	(3) by adding after subparagraph (C) the fol-

1	(c) Interpretation of Joint Resolution.—Sec-
2	tion 8 of the War Powers Resolution (50 U.S.C. 1547)

7	lowing new subsection:
8	"(d) For purposes of this joint resolution, the term
9	'post-deployment strategy' means a clear plan of action
