

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**

**19**

**OFFERED BY MR. TURNER OF OHIO**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVI, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 1614. UNFUNDED REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NATIONAL**  
2 **RECONNAISSANCE OFFICE AND THE NA-**  
3 **TIONAL GEOSPATIAL-INTELLIGENCE AGEN-**  
4 **CY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 9 of title 10, United  
6 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 222c  
7 the following new section:

8 **“§ 222d. Unfunded priorities of the National Recon-**  
9 **naissance Office and the National**  
10 **Geospatial-Intelligence Agency: annual**  
11 **report**

12 “(a) REPORTS.—Not later than 10 days after the  
13 date on which the budget of the President for a fiscal year  
14 is submitted to Congress pursuant to section 1105 of title  
15 31, each Director concerned shall submit to the Secretary  
16 of Defense and the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff,  
17 and to the congressional defense committees, a report on

1 the unfunded priorities of the element of the Department  
2 of Defense under the jurisdiction of the Director.

3 “(b) ELEMENT.—

4 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Each report under sub-  
5 section (a) shall specify, for each unfunded priority  
6 covered by such report, the following:

7 “(A) A summary description of such pri-  
8 ority, including the objectives to be achieved if  
9 such priority is funded (whether in whole or in  
10 part).

11 “(B) The additional amount of funds rec-  
12 ommended in connection with the objectives  
13 under subparagraph (A).

14 “(C) Account information with respect to  
15 such priority, including the following (as appli-  
16 cable):

17 “(i) Line Item Number (LIN) for ap-  
18 plicable procurement accounts.

19 “(ii) Program Element (PE) number  
20 for applicable research, development, test,  
21 and evaluation accounts.

22 “(iii) Sub-activity group (SAG) for  
23 applicable operation and maintenance ac-  
24 counts.

1           “(2) PRIORITIZATION OF PRIORITIES.—Each  
2 report under subsection (a) shall present the un-  
3 funded priorities covered by such report in order of  
4 urgency of priority.

5           “(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6           “(1) The term ‘Director concerned’ means—

7                   “(A) the Director of the National Recon-  
8 naissance Office with respect to matters con-  
9 cerning the National Reconnaissance Office;  
10 and

11                   “(B) the Director of the National  
12 Geospatial-Intelligence Agency with respect to  
13 matters concerning the National Geospatial-In-  
14 telligence Agency.

15           “(2) The term ‘unfunded priority’, in the case  
16 of a fiscal year, means a program, activity, or mis-  
17 sion requirement that—

18                   “(A) is not funded in the budget of the  
19 President for the fiscal year as submitted to  
20 Congress pursuant to section 1105 of title 31,  
21 United States Code;

22                   “(B) is necessary to fulfill a requirement  
23 associated with an operational or contingency  
24 plan of a combatant command or other vali-  
25 dated requirement; and

1           “(C) would have been recommended for  
2           funding through the budget referred to in para-  
3           graph (1) by the Director concerned in connec-  
4           tion with the budget if additional resources had  
5           been available for the budget to fund the pro-  
6           gram, activity, or mission requirement.”.

7           (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
8           at the beginning of chapter 9 of title 10, United States  
9           Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to  
10          section 222c the following new item:

“222d. Unfunded priorities of the National Reconnaissance Office and the Na-  
tional Geospatial-Intelligence Agency: annual report.”.
