2014)).

## 1 SEC. 2. DEVELOPMENT OF REVISED RULE.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary and the Adminis3 trator shall develop a revised proposed rule to define the
4 term "waters of the United States" as used in the Federal
5 Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq.) and
6 to identify—

7 (1) the scope or types of waters covered under8 that Act; and

9 (2) the scope or types of waters not covered10 under that Act.

(b) CONSULTATION.—In developing the revised pro-posed rule, the Secretary and the Administrator shall—

(1) consider the public comments received on
the proposed and interpretive rules referred to in
section 1; and

17 from State and local officials, stakeholders, and
18 other interested parties.

(c) PUBLICATION.—Not later than 1 year after the
date of withdrawal of the proposed and interpretive rules
under section 1, the Secretary and the Administrator shall
publish the revised proposed rule in the Federal Register.

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
