Rules Committee Print 114-30 Offered by Mr. Grijalva of Arizona

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 10. AUTHORITY REAFFIRMED.

2 (a) REAFFIRMATION.—Section 19 of the Act of June
3 18, 1934 (commonly known as the "Indian Reorganization
4 Act"; 25 U.S.C. 479), is amended—

5 (1) in the first sentence—

6 (A) by striking "The term" and inserting 7 "Effective beginning on June 18, 1934, the 8 term"; and

9 (B) by striking "any recognized Indian 10 tribe now under Federal jurisdiction" and in-11 serting "any federally recognized Indian tribe"; 12 and

(2) by striking the third sentence and inserting
the following: In said sections, the term "Indian
tribe" means any Indian or Alaska Native tribe,
band, nation, pueblo, village, or community that the
Secretary of the Interior acknowledges to exist as an
Indian tribe.

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 this section shall take effect as if included in the Act of
 June 18, 1934 (commonly known as the "Indian Reorga nization Act"; 25 U.S.C. 479), on the date of enactment
 of that Act.
